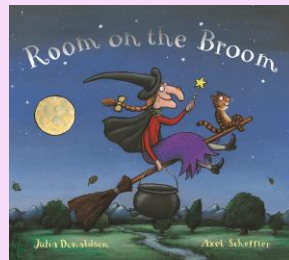


Reception News

Continued our learning about 3D shapes, extending it to 2D shapes. We learnt the names of the 2D shapes, and enjoyed going on a hunt to find 3D and 2D shapes in our environment. We also made shape pictures and sorted shapes into their correct category. We used the important words to describe shapes: edge, face, corner, curved.

What you can do at home this weekend:

- Look out for different shapes in the environment (especially unusual ones like a pentagon with 5 edges, or a hexagon with 6 edges!)
- Try to use different words to describe moving, such as bounding, fluttering, and clambering.
