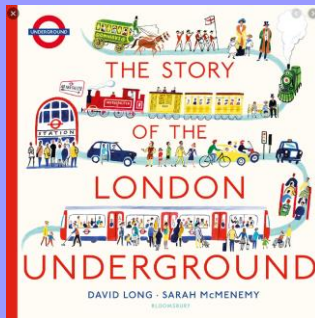


Our topic for this half term is **Transport**
