Crucial Knowledge

We are getting better at investigating places:

- Cazenove Road, Filey Avenue, Chardmore Road and Osbaldeston Road surround Jubilee Primary School.
- Jubilee School is a part of Hackney.
- The land and buildings in our local area are used for different purposes.
- Maps and aerial photographs are birds eye views.
- Maps are to scale.
- Keys are used to make maps simple to read and use.
- Geographer's use field work to understand the world. For example, looking, listening, sketching, taking photographs, asking questions and counting.



Key Vocabulary

We are getting better at communicating geographically

City: A place people live and work that is larger than a **town**.

Town: A place where humans live. Towns are *often* larger than villages but smaller than cities.

Village: A place where people live that is smaller than a town. Villages are usually in the countryside.

House: A building where people live. It usually has a ground floor and stairs.

Flat: A home that is part of a larger building. One home in the building is usually on one floor.

Shop: A building where people can buy things such as food, books or clothes.

Near: When something is close to something else. For example, the teacher is near the smart board.


Far: When something is not near to something else. For example, the park is far from the classroom.

Compass points: Compass points measure directions, such as where north or south is. A compass has a magnetic needle that points North.

Key: A picture or writing to help understand a map.

S = South


W = West




Location Maps
