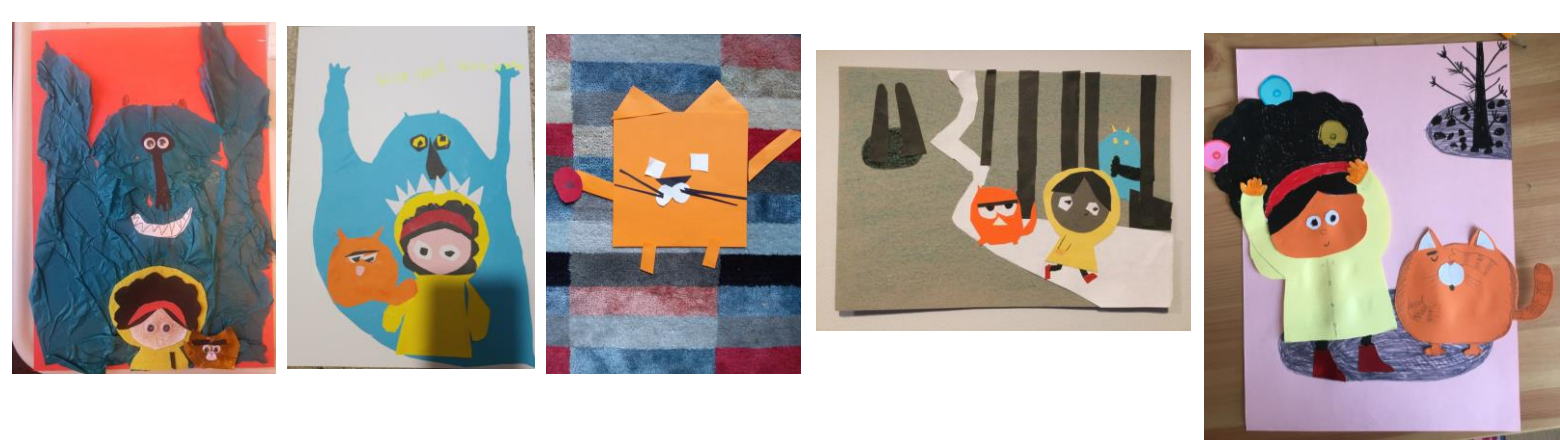

Billy and the Beast inspires awesome art in Year 1

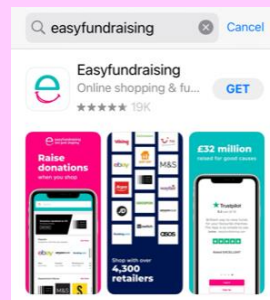

Free Money for Jubilee with easyfundraising!

Families at Jubilee raised over £600 this year, just by shopping online as normal. Since the PTA signed up for easyfundraising, we have raised a whopping £2,630 for PTA funds that go towards supporting school projects and investing in the school. It's free, it's easy, and you can do it all from an app on your phone!

What do I do?

1. Download the easyfundraising app on a phone/ipad, or click this [link](#) on a computer.
2. Select your cause: type in Jubilee School PTA (NI6)
3. Click Support this cause.
4. Create your account with your email address.
5. Click the icon of the shop you want to use. (You can choose from major retailers and travel companies such as amazon, booking.com, ebay, John Lewis, Just eat, Argos, New Look, Boden, Tu clothing, Monsoon, Jigsaw, Selfridges, M&S, trainline.com, expedia.com, TUI.... The list goes on!)
This will link you through to the chosen website as normal.
6. Shop as normal. The shop will make a donation to Jubilee when you make your purchase. Sometimes this can be as much as 6%.

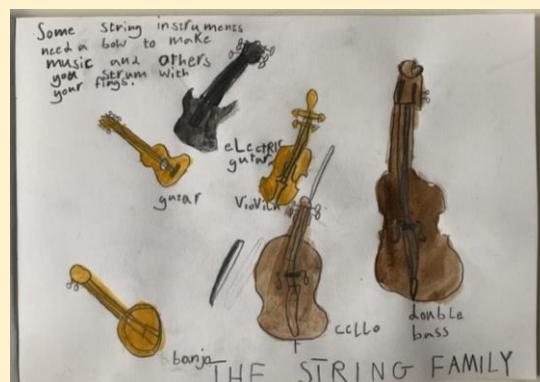
