

- "What kind of bear did you see in the story?"

- Finding out about all the resources in the nursery, how to use and them and where they go.
- Learning the names of the adults and some of the other children.
- Practising how to sit in a circle on the carpet for fruit time.
- Finding out how to put on an apron by ourselves in order to paint and play in the water tray.
- Talking about our favourite toys
- Learning how to take turns using a sand timer to time each person's turn
- Practising how to put on an apron for water play and painting
