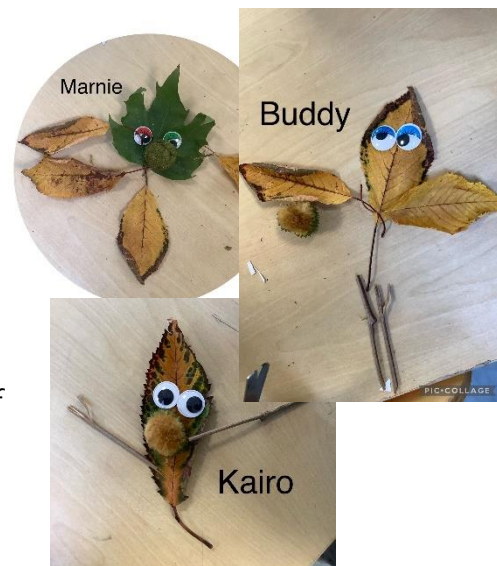


Messy Maps in Year 1
