## On the Farm

#### Crucial Knowledge

##### *I will learn that...*

- Animals on the farm have different features and sounds.
- Farms are places that produce foods or other grown produce (e.g. flowers), either by growing or keeping animals.
- Animals on the farm require looking after, including feeding and caring for their health (e.g. sheep shearing, vet checks).
- Farms often use special vehicles to help them do farming jobs (e.g. combine harvester, tractors).
- Farms around the world are different, depending on the animals that live in that country and what the weather is like there.
- Foods we eat might start by being grown on the farm (e.g. wheat to make into bread).
- Some animals hatch from eggs, including ducklings and cygnets.
- Easter is a spring celebration for many families that is characterised by decorative eggs, exchanging chocolate eggs or bunnies, and family events.
- Some Christian families visit church at Easter.
- Mother's Day is a celebration for many families to say thank you to mothers.

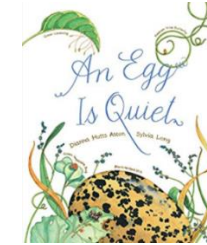

- Explain how animals on the farm might need caring for

- Show an understanding of the range of animals that hatch from eggs
- Explain a few ways that people celebrate Easter.
- Note a few seasonal changes that Spring brings.
- Understand that Mothers' Day is a day that is celebrated by many families

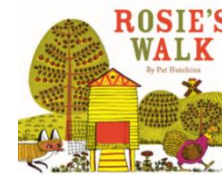
