## National Education Union: Teachers' Strike

On Thursday 2nd March the NEU will again be out on strike. This is because no resolution has been found between the NEU and the government in the dispute over school funding and pay.

# Safer Internet Day

On 7th February, it was Safer Internet Day. We marked the day throughout the school with Computing lessons all about the wonderful things we use the internet for and some of the dangers that can be associated with it.

The theme for Safer Internet Day 2023 was **Want to talk about it? Making space for conversations about life online**. The big focus was on the issues that are most pertinent to children now. Across the school, pupils discussed the things they enjoy doing online and talked about some of the online issues which felt most important to them. They also thought about the importance of telling a trusted adult if something comes up on the internet that doesn't feel right.

We have started the conversation about the internet in school and it would be great if you could carry it on at home - talk to your child about what they love doing online and about what kinds of issues could arise.
